

Changing a Retraction Valve



- 1) Pinch off 'water in' line going to retraction valve.
- Carefully disconnect all three tubes connected to the retraction valve, noting which one goes to each location.
- Unpinch 'water in' tubing while holding open end over sink or towel. Flush out water line for a few seconds, then pinch off 'water in' tube again.
- Re-connect all three lines to the new retraction valve. Be sure each line goes back at the original position, as on the above diagram.

NOTE: The in line check valve threads into the retraction valve and can be re-used on the new retraction valve.
